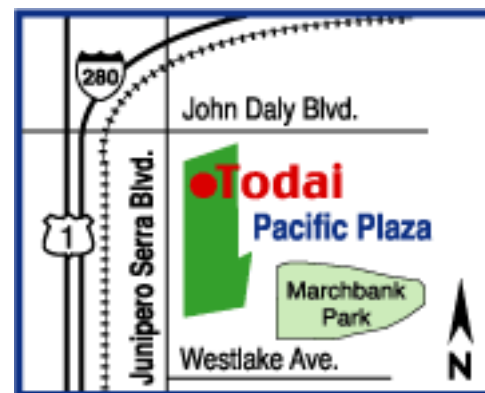

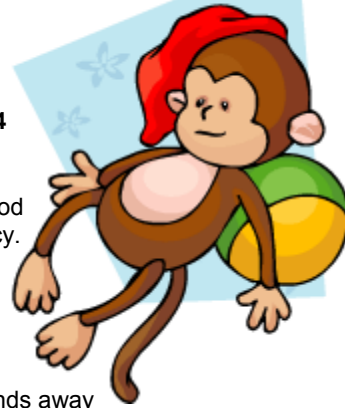

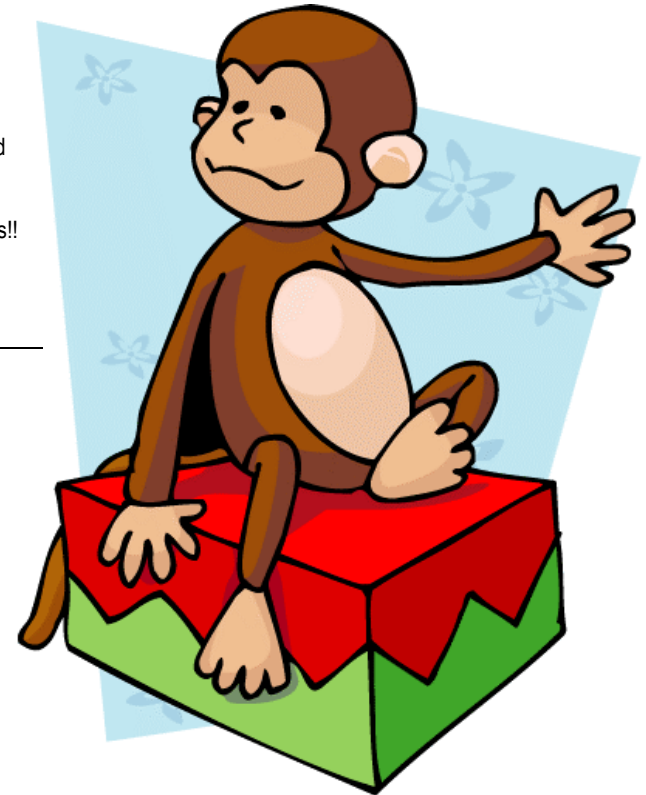
ABOUT US
